

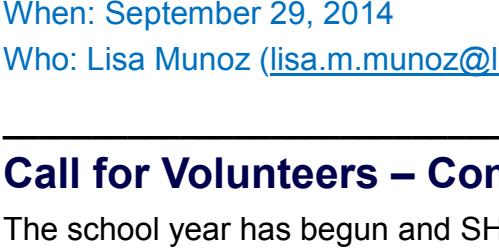

## 2014-2015 Trinity HS SHPE Jr. Mentoring



The SHPE Jr. program is an after school mentoring program aimed at increasing Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) awareness by changing the lives of young Hispanic high schools by encouraging them to go on and pursue STEM college studies and careers. The high school SHPE Jr. advisor, Jr. Chapter officers held their strategic planning meeting this past Friday, August 29 after school, and planned out their budget and calendar for the year. The SHPE Jr. mentoring program is a SHPE National program that meets typically twice a month for 1.5 hours each and includes a professional development workshop focused on preparing high schools for college, exploring college options, or scholarship, and one science or engineering activity. Are you looking for a way to give back to the local community and help change lives? Are you in a LM early career technical leadership development program and need a way to fulfill the basic leadership development program requirements by volunteering in the community to assist Lockheed Martin in meeting its employee strategic community outreach objectives.
