Dr. Eksir will field questions from the audience after he concludes his talk.

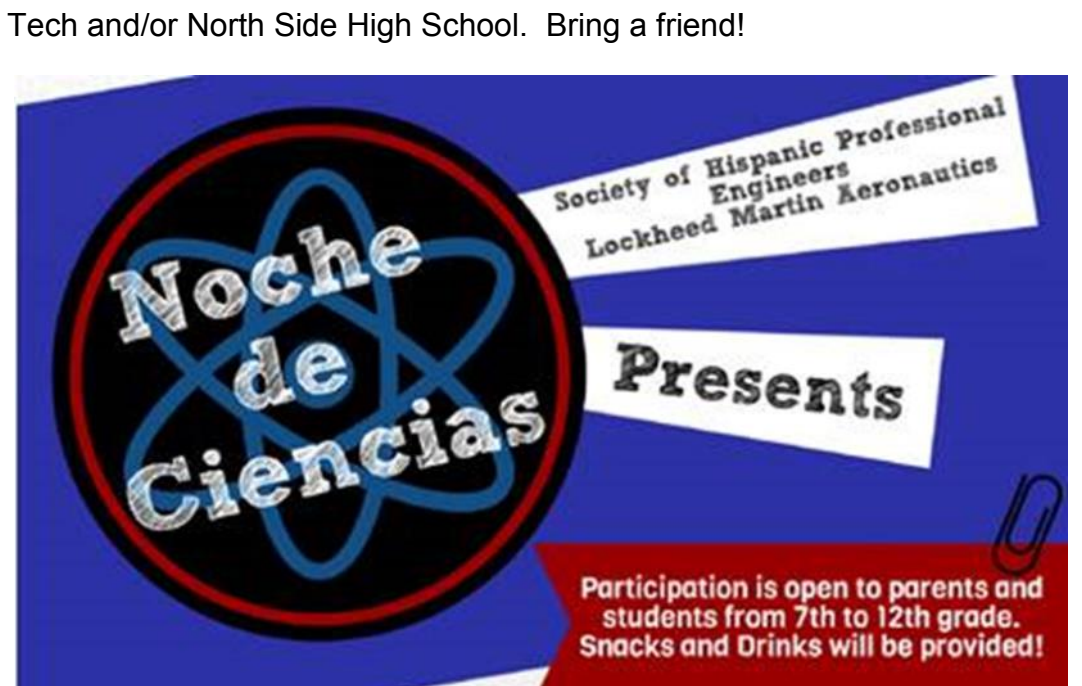

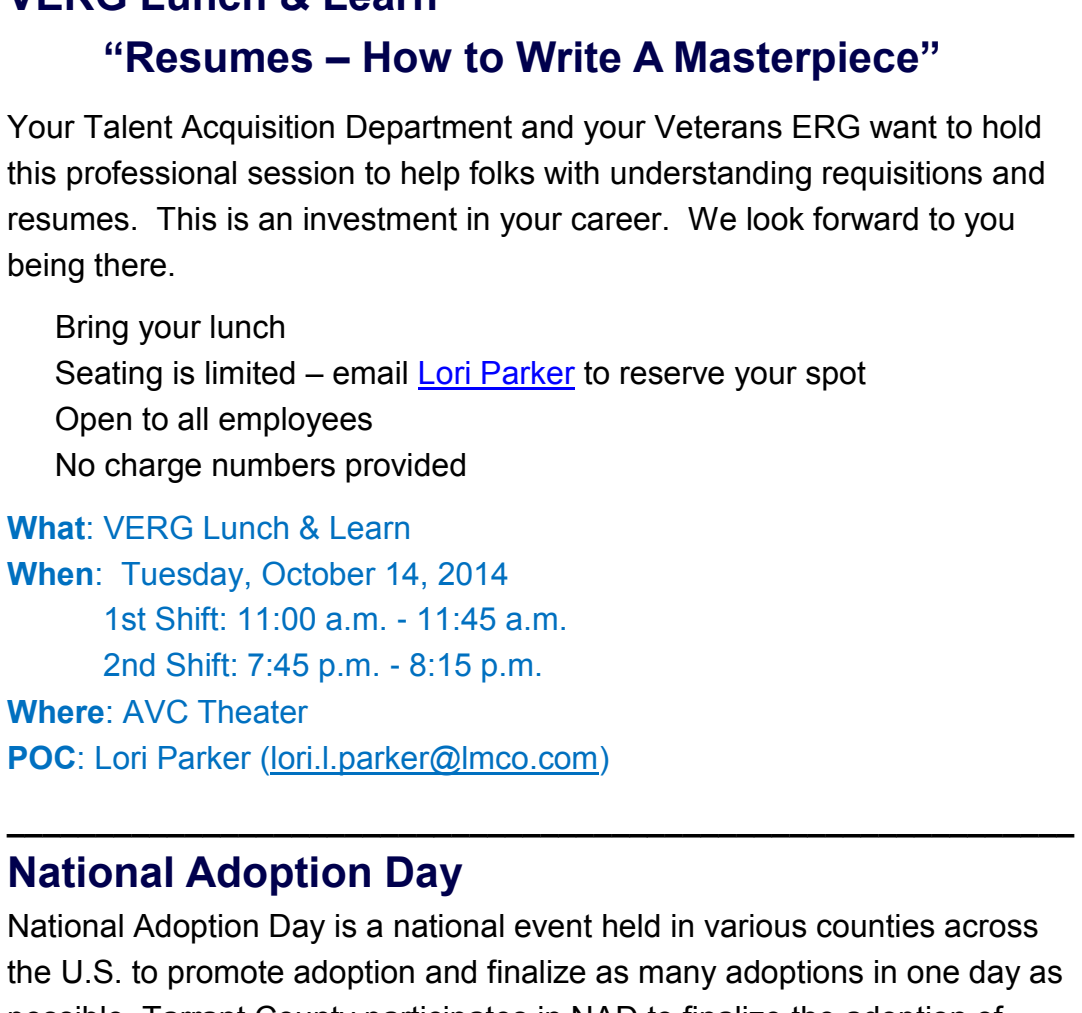
