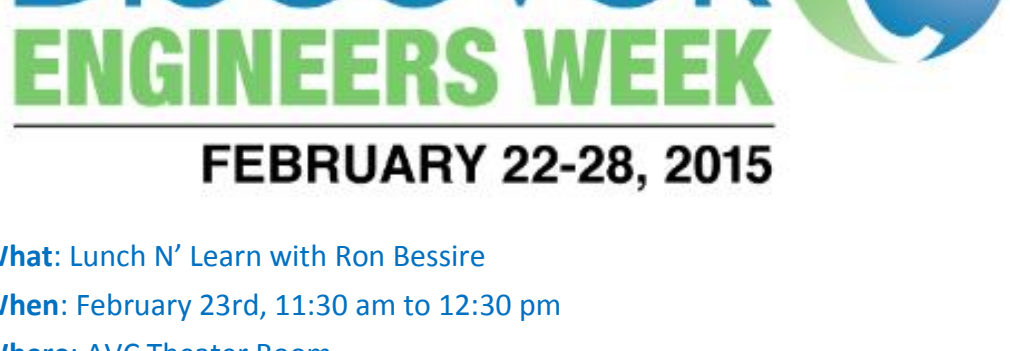

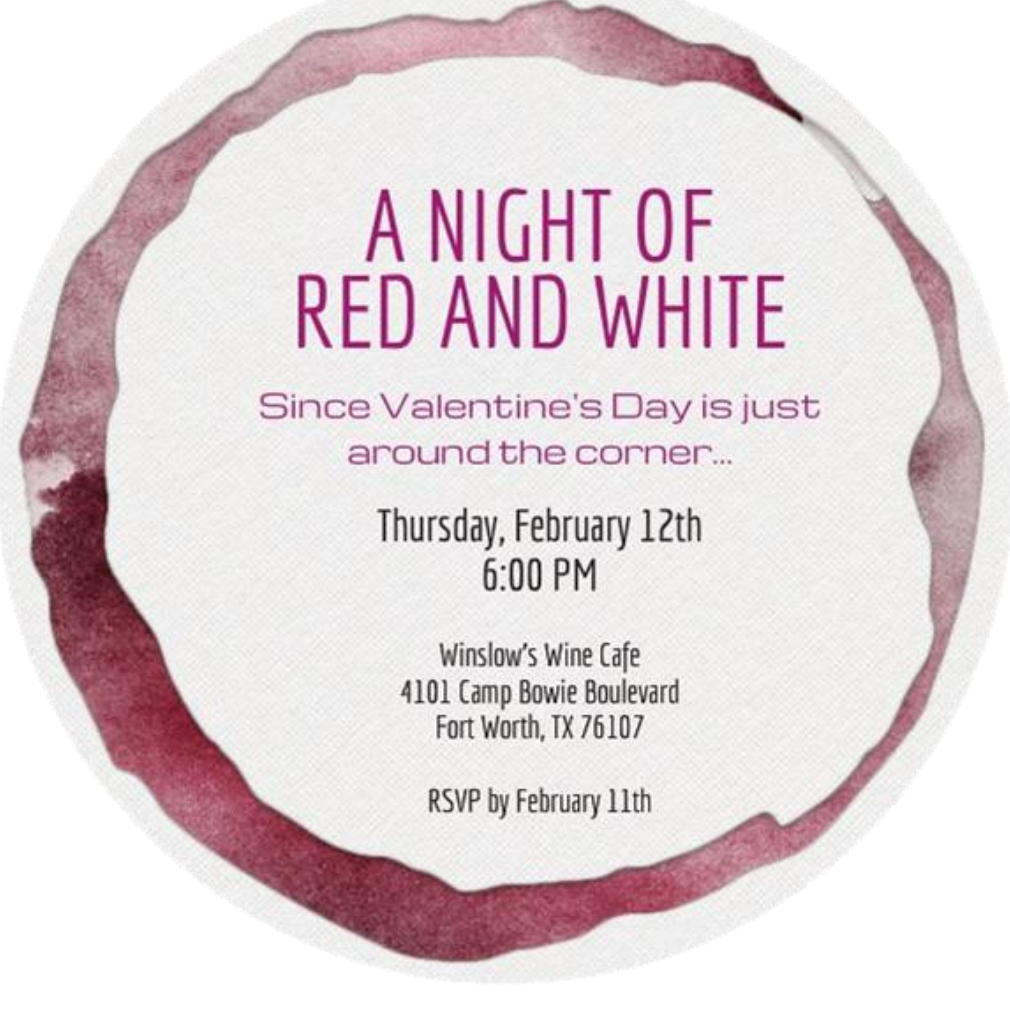

## SHPE Valentine's Day Mixer

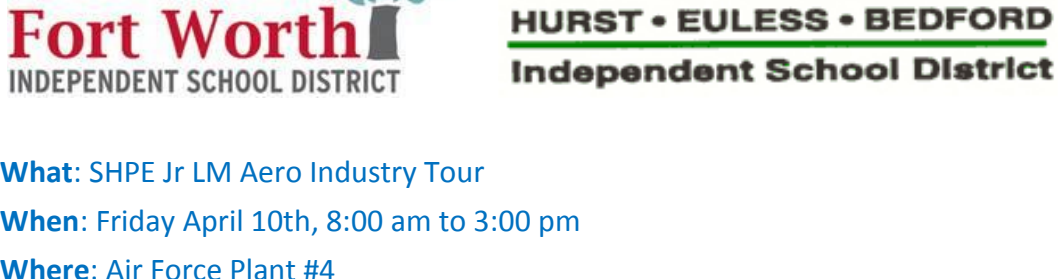

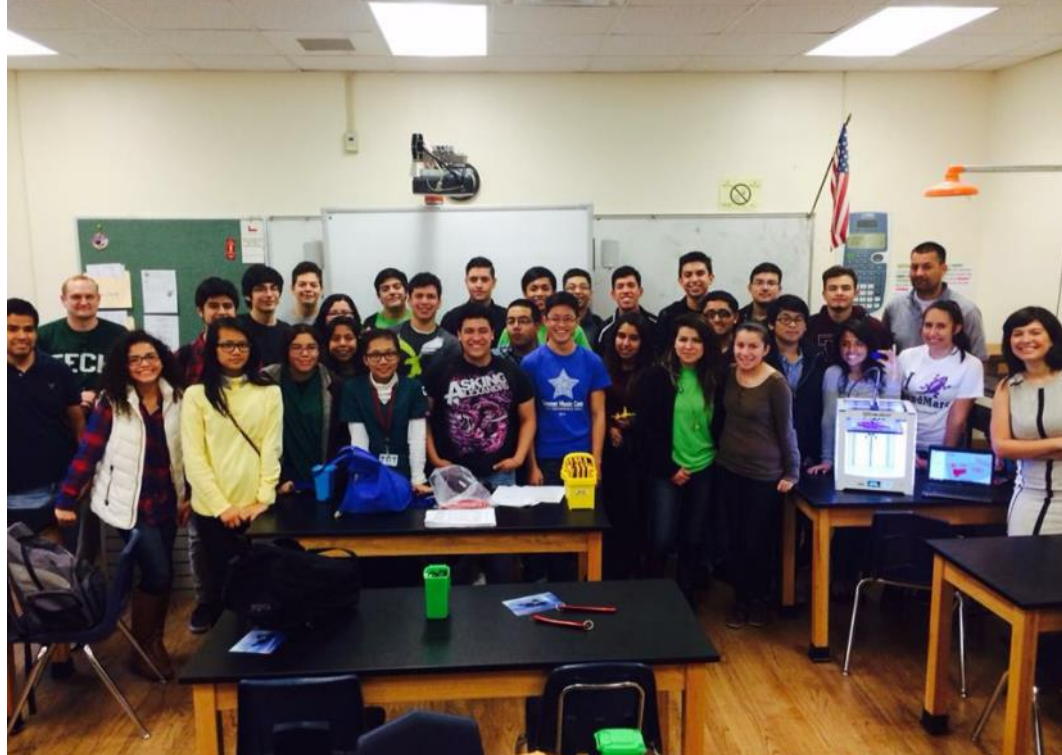

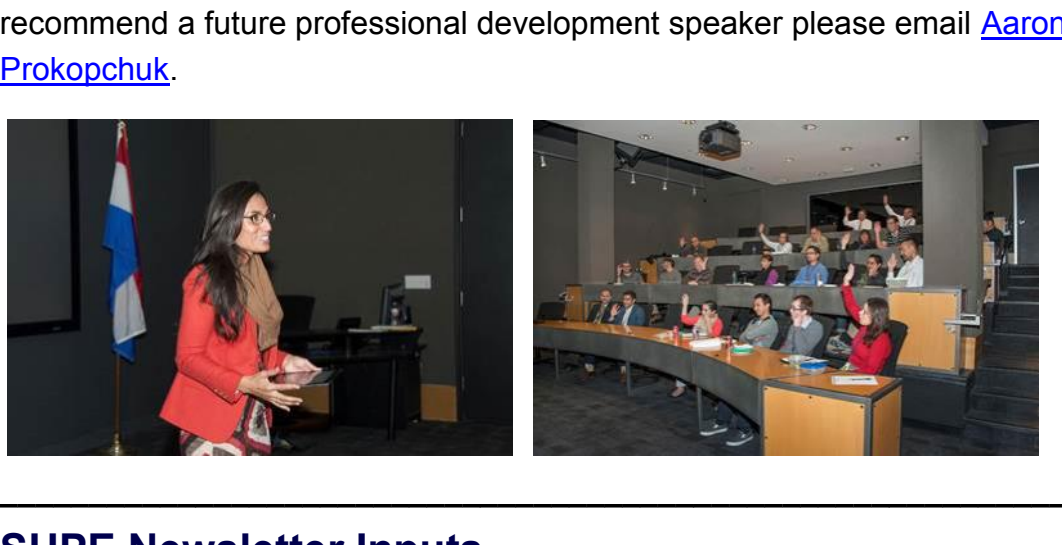
