2015-2016 Chapter Elections

It's time to nominate our next SHPE LM Aero leaders! There are five elected officer positions and six appointed positions that need to be filled. If you are interested in running for an elected position please contact Juan Tezanos by **Friday, May 15th**. Positions up for election include:

President:

Responsible for setting the strategic vision and goals for the chapter as well as developing plans for achieving them. Presides over the SHPE Board of Directors (BOD) meetings, and has the authority to appoint and dismiss ad hoc committees and committee chairs. Should be knowledgeable of the chapter's policies and procedures and readily available to assist BOD members in achieving chapter goals.

Vice President of Professional Development (PD)

Assist the President by focusing on matters regarding chapter strategic, leadership, and professional development goals. Responsible for coordination and implementation of programs and events aimed at providing professional and development for chapter members.

Vice President of Community Outreach (CO)

Assist the President by focusing on matters regarding community outreach. Responsible for coordination and implementation of K-12 and college level programs and events aimed at providing STEM awareness, access, and preparation to Hispanic students in Fort Worth.

Treasurer

Along with the chapter president, responsible for chapter finances. This includes processing payments and reimbursements, performing audits, maintaining transaction records, and submitting all state and federal tax reports.

Secretary

Assists the president with coordination of BOD, general, and committee meetings. Records meeting minutes, and distributes and tracks action items. Coordinates the election of officers, and aid in the transition between incoming and outgoing BOD.

Appointed positions include Director of SHPE Jr, Director of Events, Chapter Historian, Director of Communications, and Director of Membership. These positions will be appointed after the new BOD has been elected.
