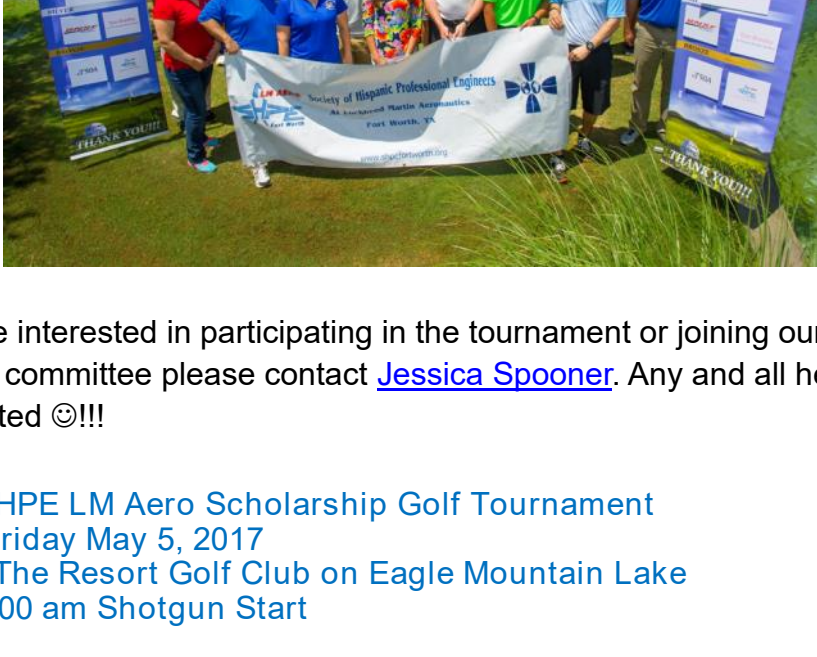

- Event Staff (3 volunteers)

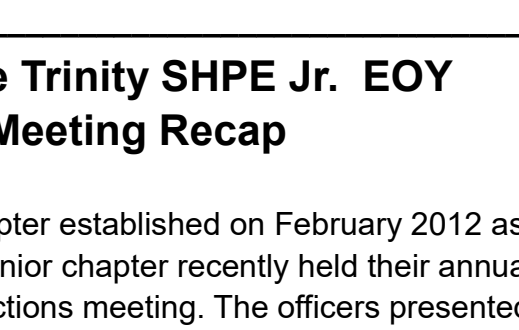
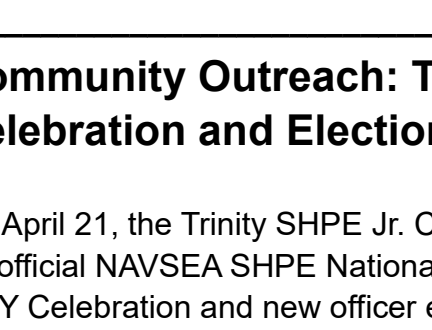

Community Outreach: SHPE LM Aero Professional Tour Series Program Recap

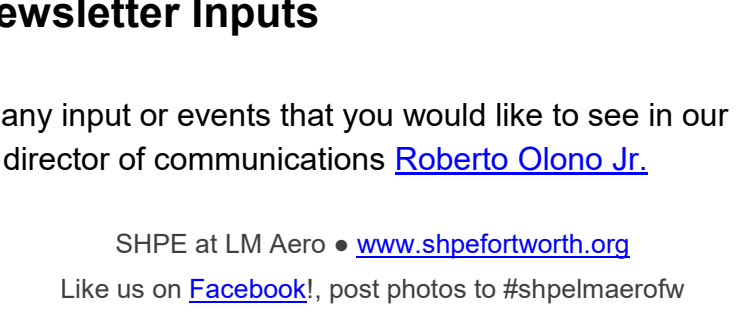

Professional Development: SHPE RLDC5 Recap

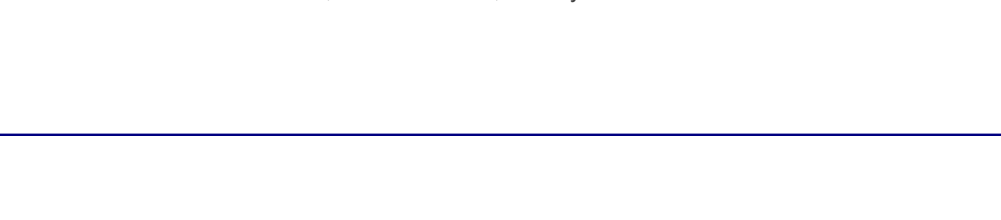

There was total attendance of 364 including 245 students, 37 corporate professionals, and 18 SHPE Jr. Pre-College high school students from across SHPE Region 5 including Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Mississippi, and Tennessee. This exceeded the RLDC5 planning committee expectations/goals by about 100 attendees. This is the chapter's largest fundraising event.
